

3D printed crosses

1. Preparing

- a. Cut ties in half
- b. Clean up pendants with craft knife
 - Open loops
 - Remove rough spots
 - Remove strings
- c. Cut twine into 3 feet lengths

1. Cleaning

- a. Soak crosses in soapy water,
- b. rub clean,
- c. rinse in clean water
- d. and dry
- e. Wash twine in soapy water,
- f. rinse in clean water
- g. and hang up to dry

2. Assembling

- a. Thread pendant
- b. Tie knot and test by pulling tight
- c. Trim ends of twine

3. Packaging

- a. Loop twine around two fingers
- b. Wrap tie around loops
- c. Secure tag with same tie
- d. Put into the clear plastic package
- e. Staple Church card to package

- f. Pray over cross
- g. 7 packages in each cloth bag

There are many meanings for each color. Here are a few:

- Red: The Blood of Christ
- Red Crystal: Love and Sacrifice
- White: Innocence
- Gold: King of Kings
- Silver: Purity and Redemption
- Blue: Loyalty and Truth
- Crystal: Clarity and Insight
- Purple: Royalty and Authority
- Black: Solemn (Serious)
