Attached are the STL files I promised you. There is also a .txt file with the slicer settings, print scaling, filament changes and machine settings I have been using. The scaling allows me to base my CAD model on a 2-inch coin but still generate a 3-inch print when I want. The 3-inch coins are more popular, but I wonder how your printers would perform with a 2-inch print. My enders can't do these designs well at 2 inches due to the feature size of the images and QR codes.

The "merry christmas" and "barefoot angel" files are from a customer's design. I also included my business card in case you wanted to try printing a QR code.

I have been considering how we might establish a workflow between our two businesses. I want to continue designing and selling my designs to customers, but it is cost prohibitive for me to rebuild my printer farm without more sales. And frankly, I like designing more than printing anyway. With your printer farm, we could form a great collaboration, with you supplying the prints of my designs. Pricing is an issue we would need to look at carefully. I have some thoughts on the subject, but maybe we should wait until we meet again to begin that discussion.
