

I have removed 15 grab bars previously installed for my elderly father from walls and door frames.

There are 3 more grab bars installed in a walk-in shower's plastic enclosure. I will leave these unless there is a way to patch the plastic at a reasonable price.

Here are the details for the holes that require patching:

8 screw holes in exterior door frames need wood filler and brown paint

16 screw holes in interior door frames need wood filler and white paint

6 grab bar anchor holes (1 ½ inch diameter) in bathrooms need patch, sanding and white paint

4 grab bar anchor holes (1 ½ inch diameter) in living room need patch, sanding, texturing and cream-colored paint

6 screw holes in interior door need wood filler and white paint

22 screw holes in bathroom drywall need spackling, sanding and white paint

6 screw-with-plastic anchor holes in bedroom drywall need spackling, sanding texturing and cream-colored paint

Additionally there is a 2 feet by 2 feet interior wall section that was repeatedly scraped by Dad's recliner and needs texturing and cream-colored paint
