

TEXT MESSAGE 1 (Initial Exit Message):

I won't be returning to Rocketown Church.

Months ago, I asked Pastor Steve directly whether the church had a problem with science. He said no—but now I see that it does.

The science of evolution is accepted by the global scientific community. The fake science of creationism is not. It's theology pretending to be science, and it's only accepted in churches that insist on denying the truth.

TEXT MESSAGE 2 (Harder Follow-Up If They Respond):

Steve, I'm going to be clear, because clarity is love.

You asked me not to speak about theistic evolution because it contradicts what you believe. But what you believe is not true. It isn't science—it's theology disguised as science. It does not hold up under scrutiny, and the scientific community knows this.

You told me I can believe what I want, but then asked me to stay silent. That's not coexistence. That's control. And especially when it comes to teaching children, silence becomes complicity. I won't lie by omission.

This isn't a personality clash. It's not a misunderstanding. It's a fundamental incompatibility between what your church teaches and what I know to be true. I'm not interested in debating it. I'm not here to negotiate reality.

I'm not angry. But I am done.
